FEWA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

F.E.W.A. Foundation's purpose in awarding scholarships is to provide assistance to children of families involved in diverse workplaces, who aspire to pursue scholastic endeavors post-high school or equivalent. Such assistance and awards are not limited to schooling or educational training in the United States.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR F.E.W.A. FOUNDATION SCHOLASTIC AWARDS (FEWA Foundation use only)

1. Eligibility:
 - a. Must be a son or daughter of an Employer or Worker in a company with a diverse work force.
 - b. Must pursue post high-school scholastic or educational endeavors. (i.e. college, trade school, culinary school, etc...)
2. Requirements:
 - a. One recommendation from F.E.W.A. member (either employer member or worker member is sufficient). Other recommendations will be considered (limit 3).
 - b. Proof that such applicant's parent; stepparent or legal guardian is employed in a diverse workplace.
 - c. One copy of transcripts and presentation of grade point average or grade point average equivalent.
 - d. Personal Statement (Essay – Describing Career Objectives - 500 word max.)
 - e. Proof of admission to a post-high school academic institution (i.e. letter of acceptance to the school and contact information of such school's admissions officer). Payment will be made to the educational institution.
3. Budget:
 - a. FEWA Foundation board of directors at their discretion may direct funds in the amount to approximately \$15,000 annually. Of this amount, \$12,000 shall be designated towards scholarships. \$3000 of the scholarship fund shall be designated towards the costs and expenses of the committee in overseeing and maintaining the scholarship program.
 - b. This fund shall be divided in half whereby two \$6000 funds shall be established. The worker and employer member scholarship funds shall each award three \$1000 scholarships and six \$500 scholarships annually if the funds allow.

4. Criteria

- a. FEWA Foundation scholarship may only be received once per individual.
- b. Family member of contributors to the scholarship fund are not eligible for scholarships.
- c. Children of officers and directors of FEWA and FEWA Foundation are not eligible to receive a scholarship.
